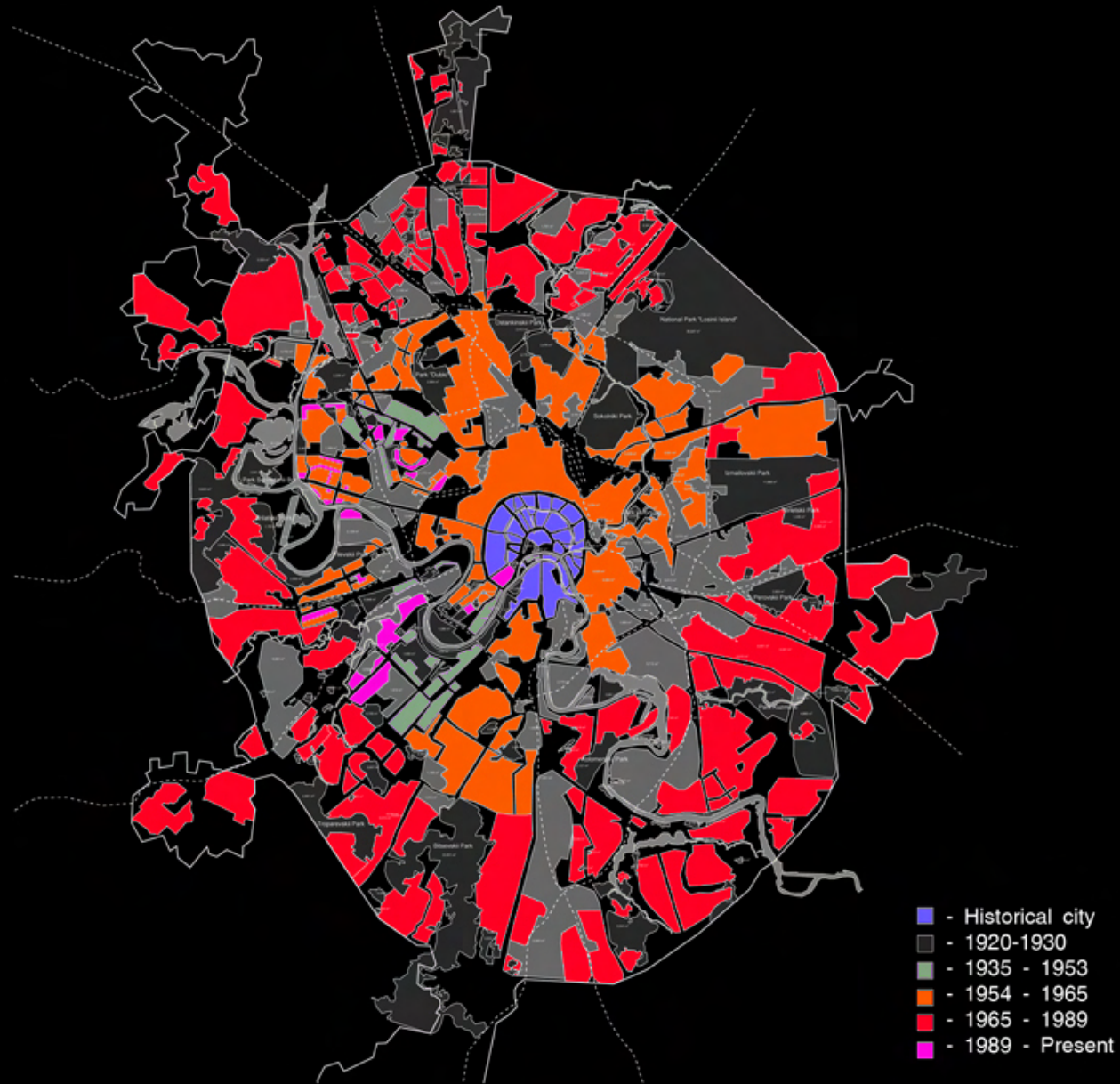

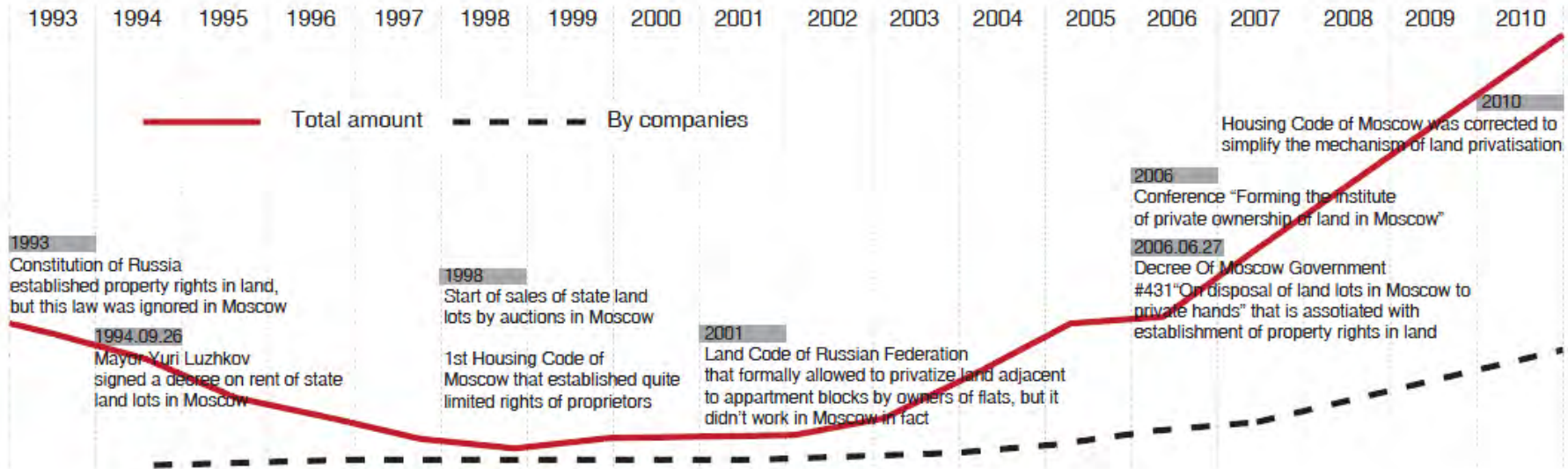

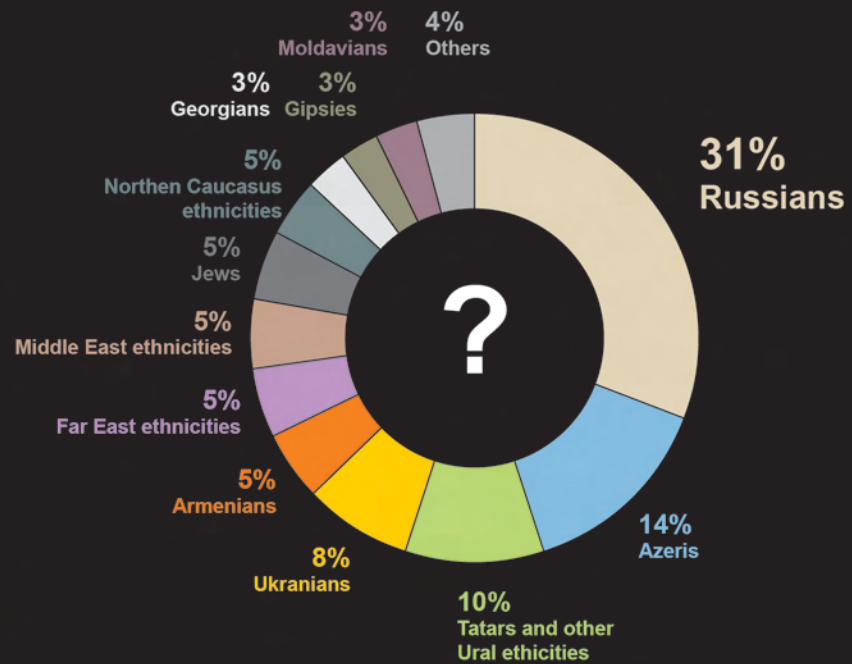
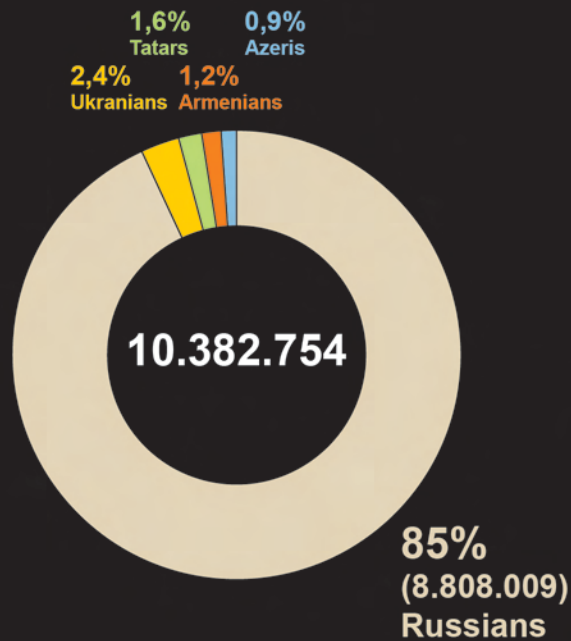
**1st private commerce land**

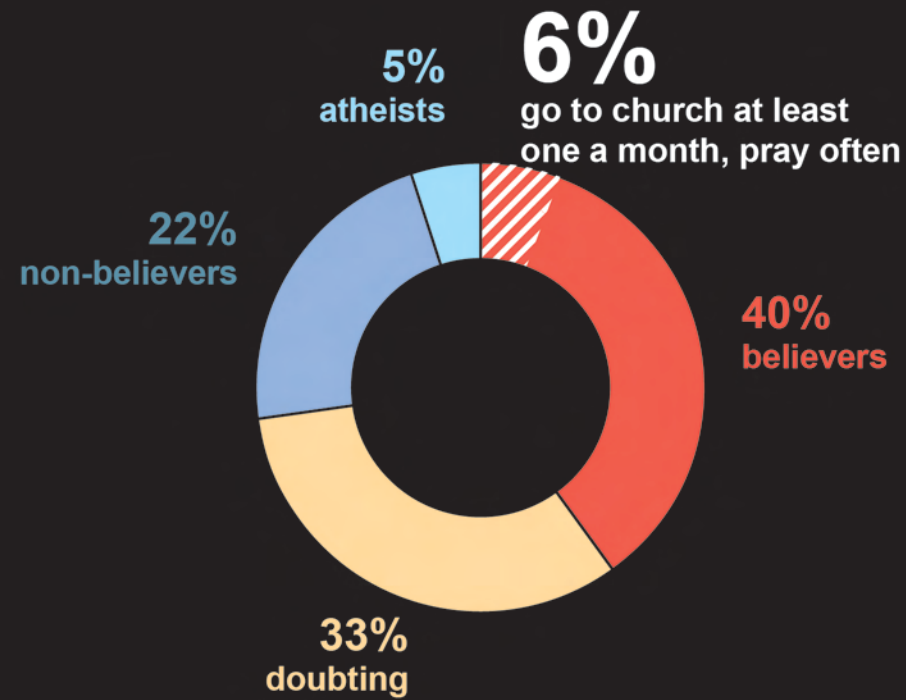

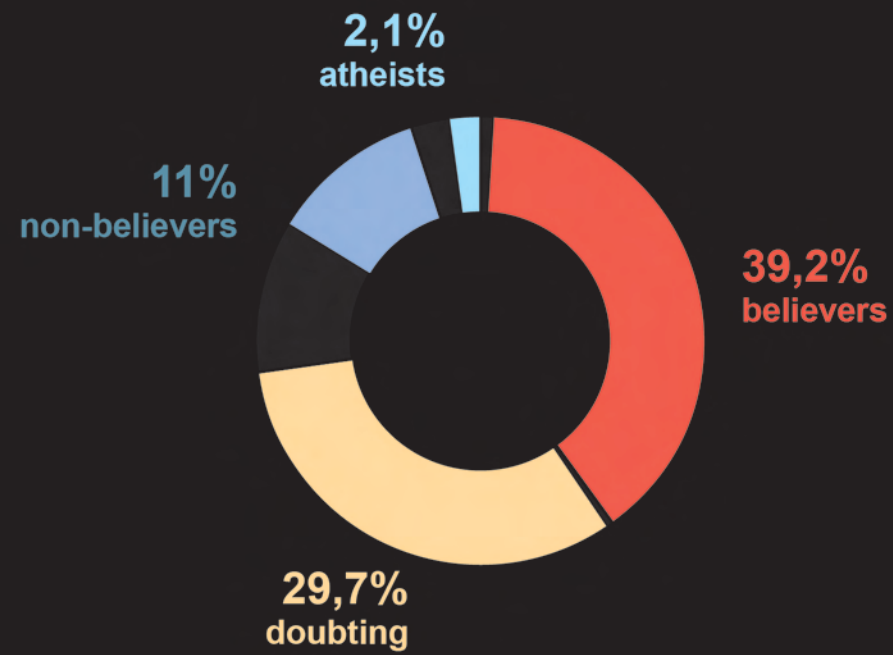

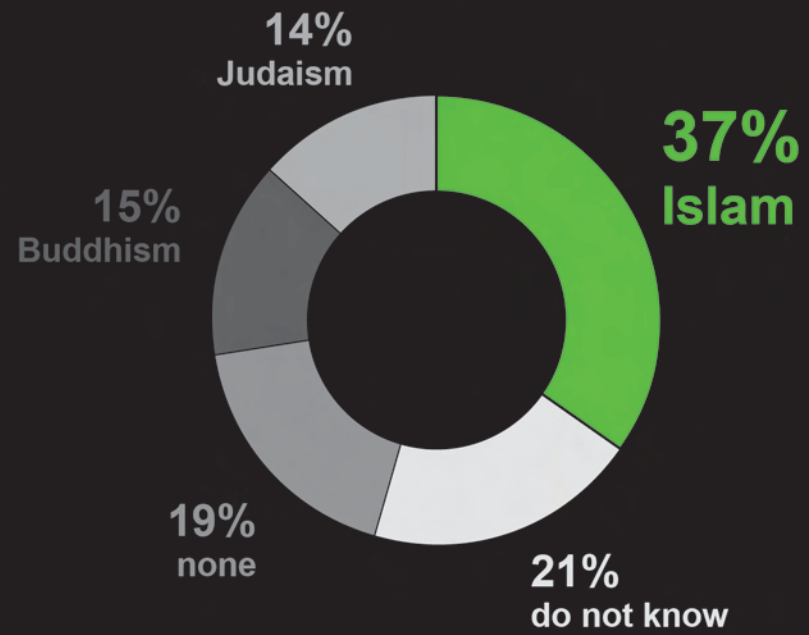


# 83% OF MOSCOVITES NAME THEMSELVES ORTHODOX

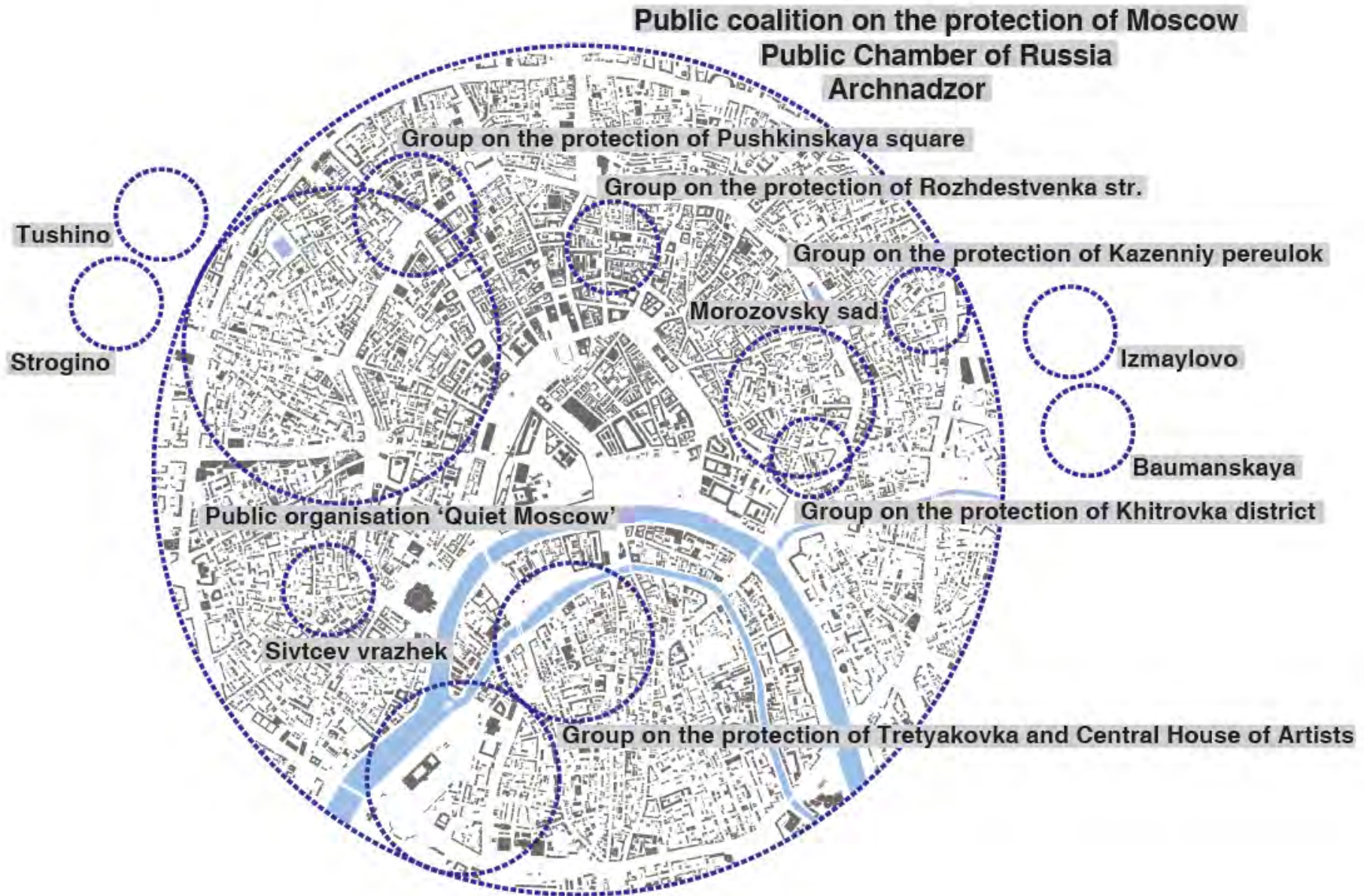

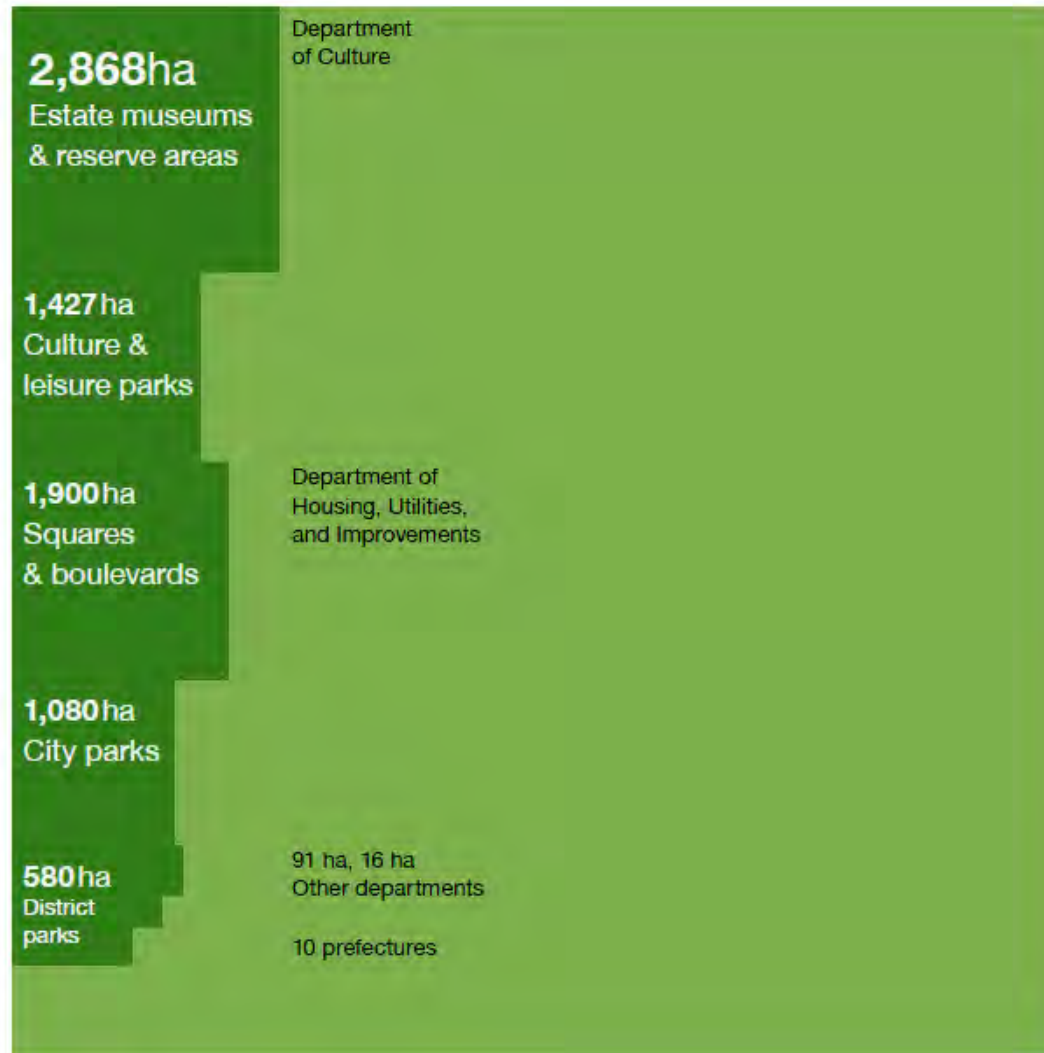

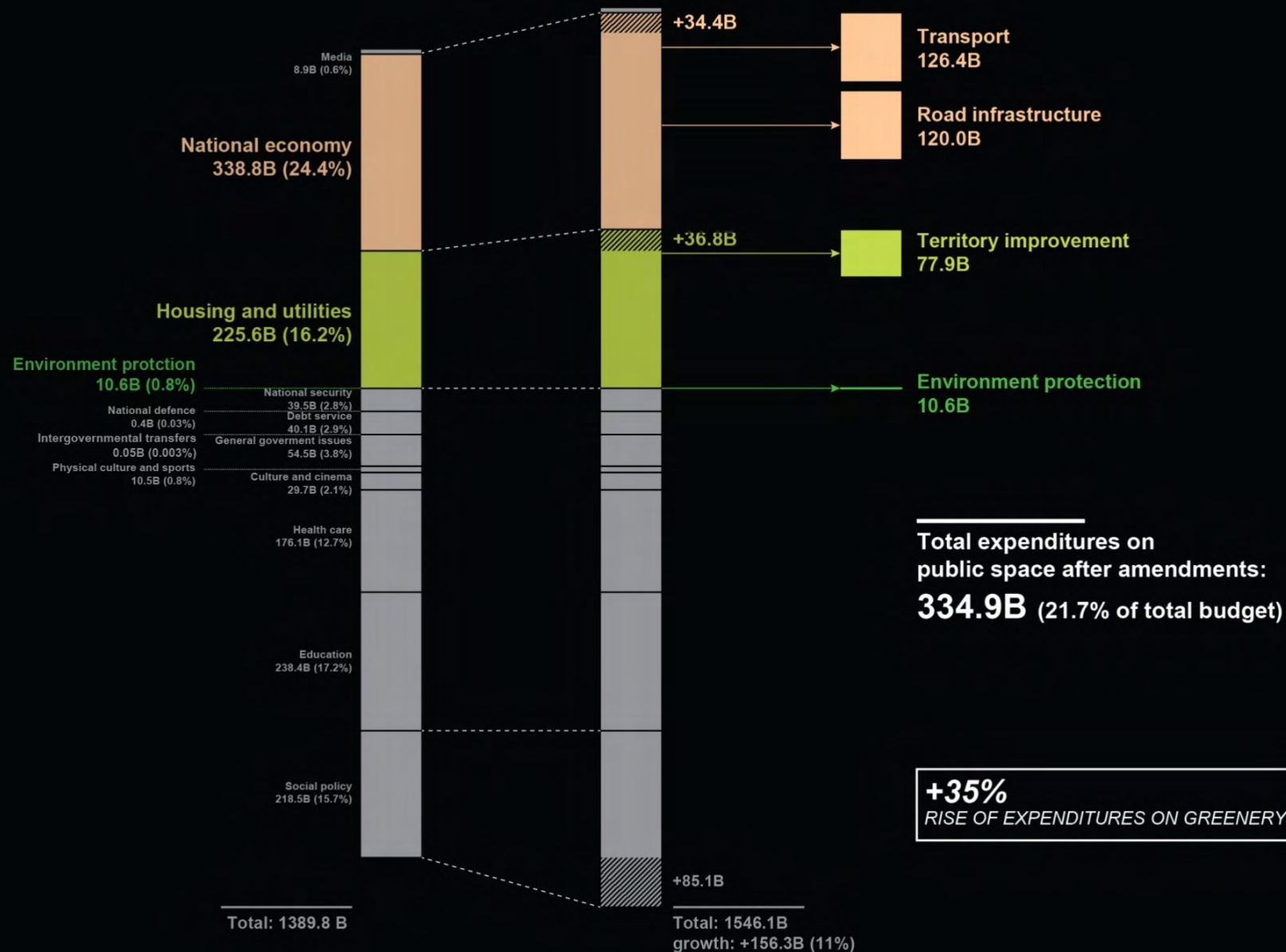
